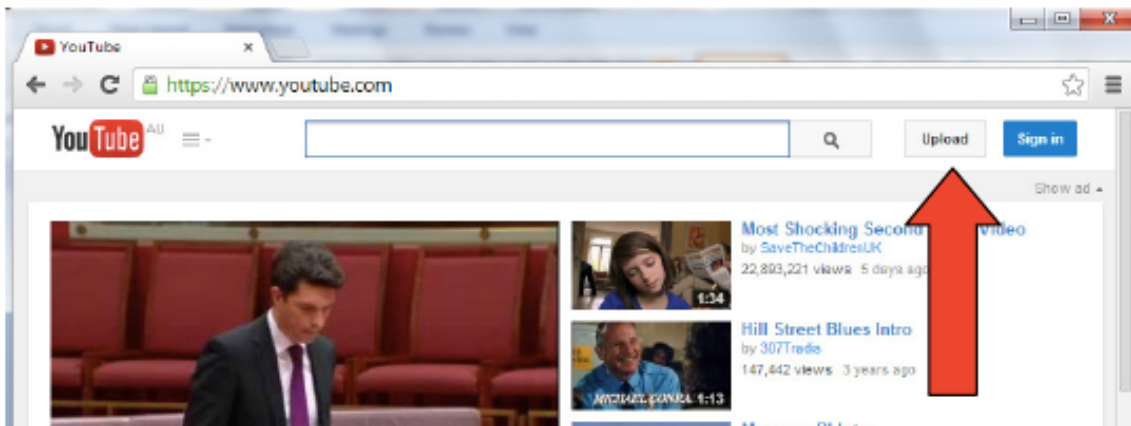
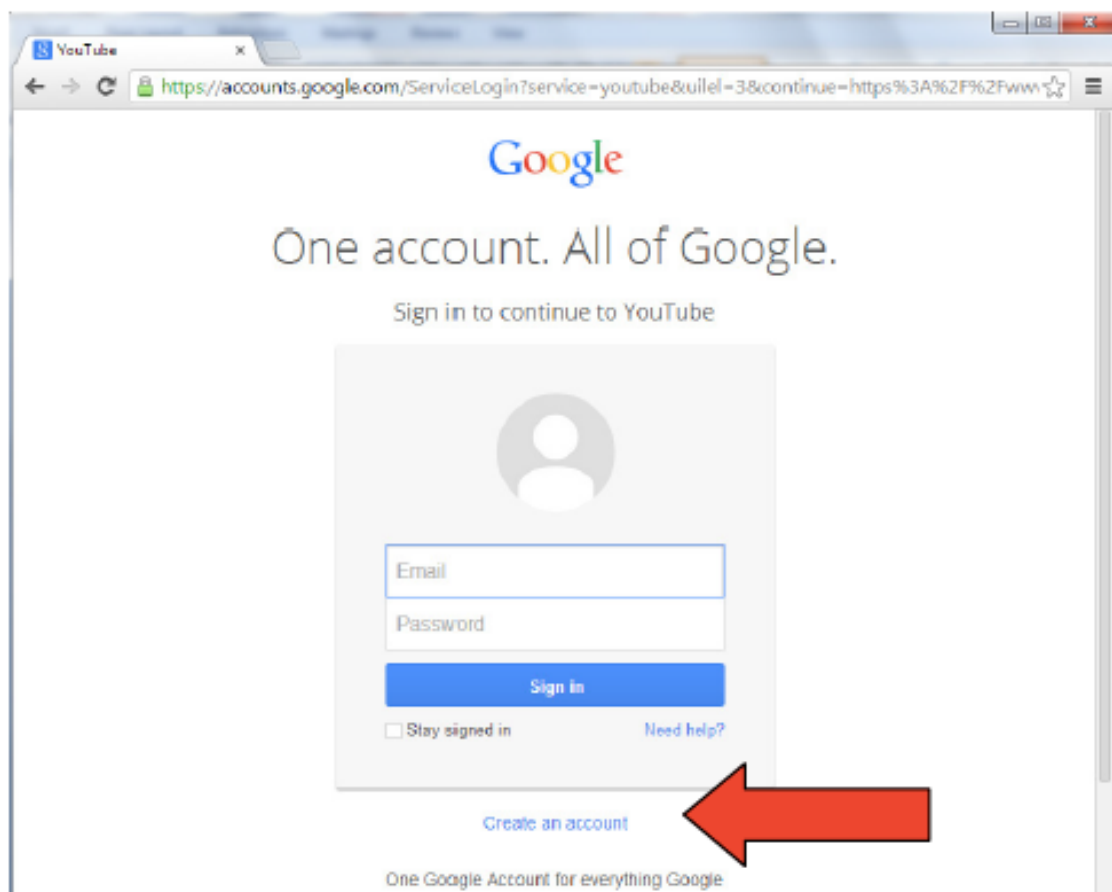


How to Upload Your Audition Video to YouTube and Send it to FOOSA


1. Go to www.youtube.com and click on UPLOAD in the top righthand corner.



2. If you already have a Google account, then enter your email and password. If you don't, you'll need to create one by clicking on "Create an account" (see arrow).




3. For those creating an account, enter your details.



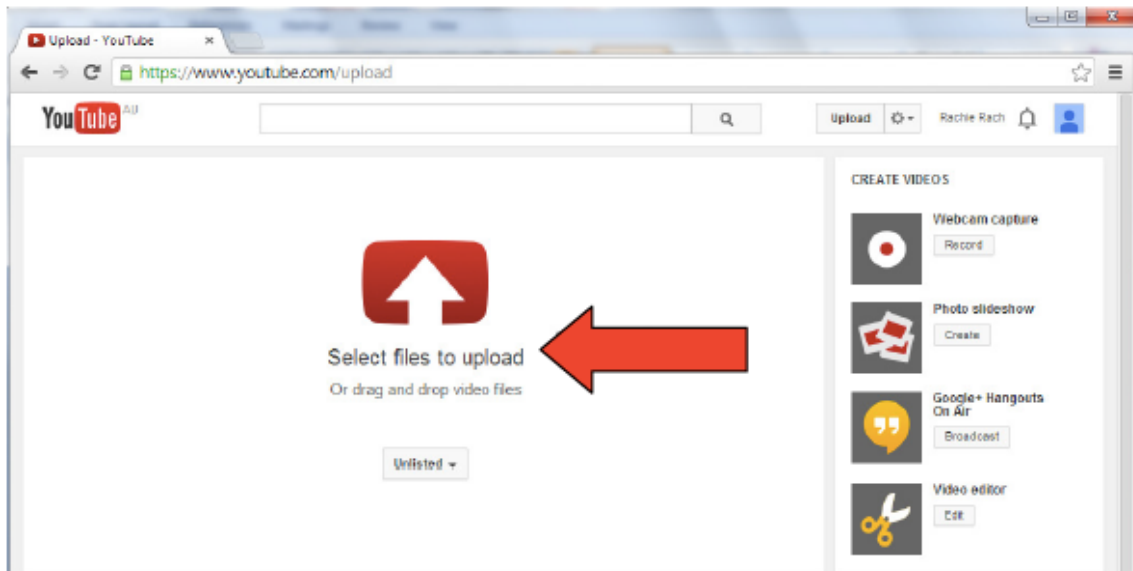

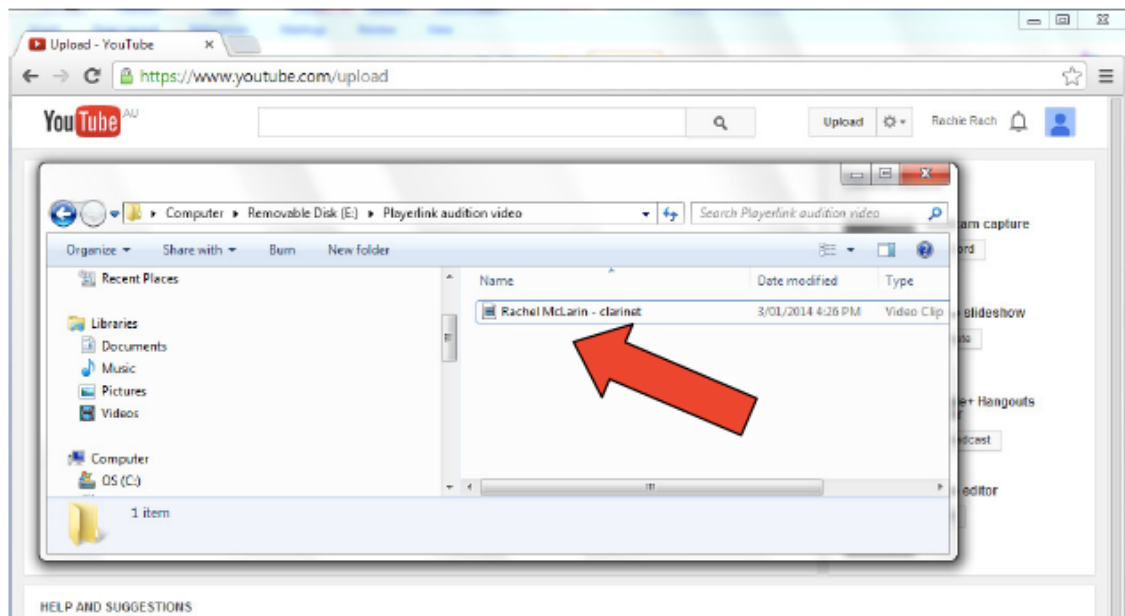

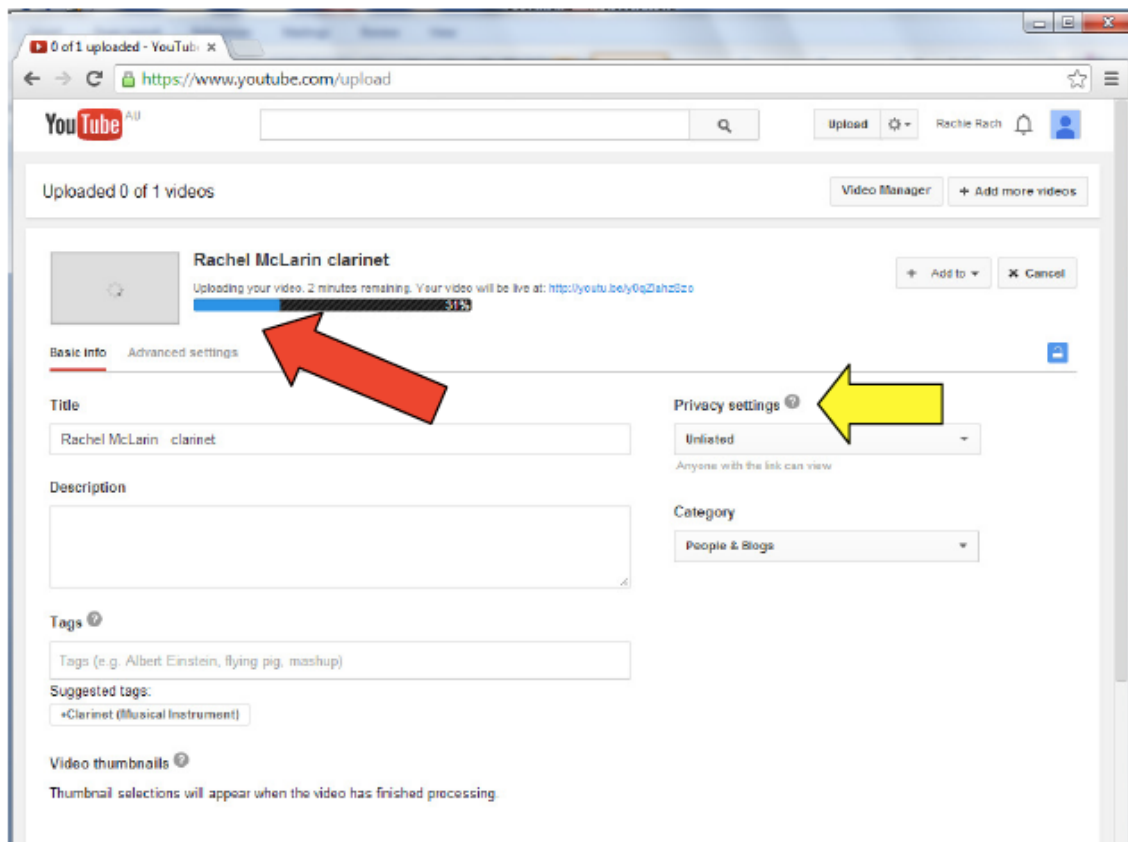
5. Now you're ready to upload your video. Click on "Select Files to Upload."



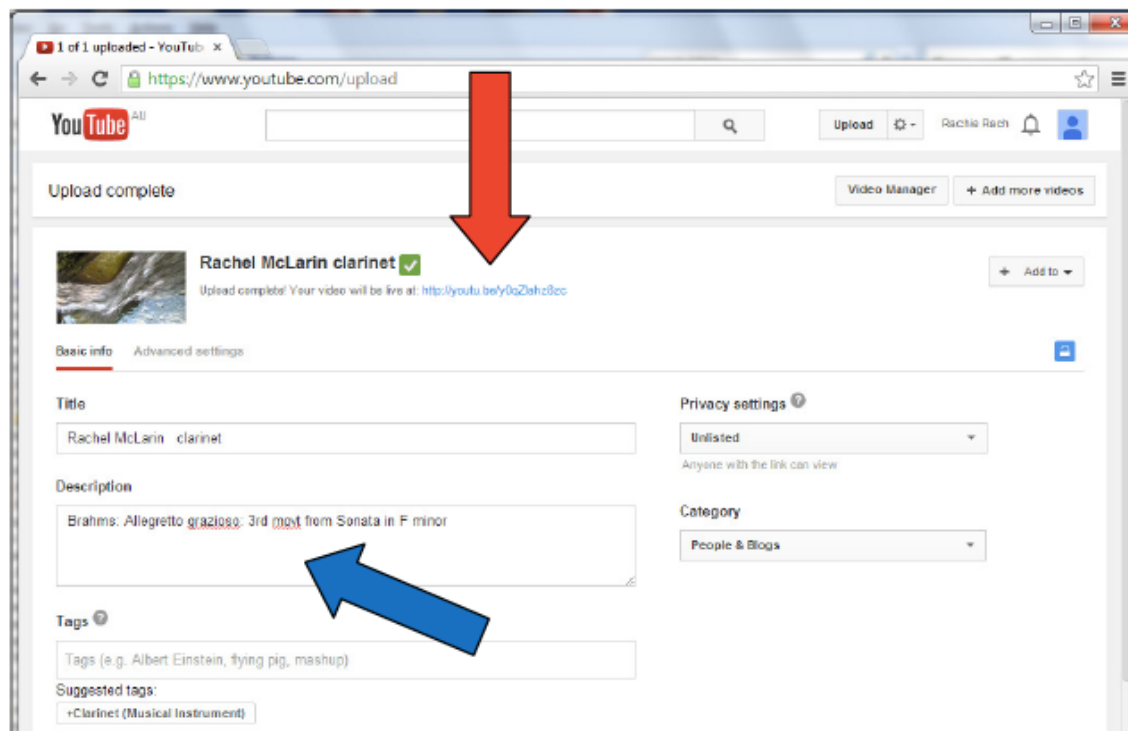
6. Navigate to where your video is stored on your computer and select your video.



7. Your video will start to upload. It may take a few minutes (red arrow). NB: Make sure that "unlisted" is showing under the privacy settings (yellow arrow).



8. Enter in the “Description” box (blue arrow) the name of the piece/movement/etude/scale(s) you are submitting as your audition material. Once your video has uploaded email the link (red arrow) to foosamusic@gmail.com with the audition video + player’s name in the subject line.
